Cover a wide range of price points. Less expensive items allow guests to put a collection of gifts together, plus they give options to those who can't spend as much. But don't be afraid to put more expensive items on your registry. Groups of friends or family will often go in together on an item. And you never know when someone wants to be exceptionally generous. Don't limit their generosity.

Check your registry periodically leading up to your event. Continue to add items as the number of available items becomes limited. Be sure to keep that broad range of price points.

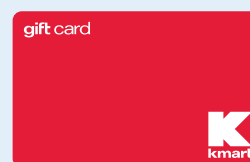
Think outside the box, no matter what event you're celebrating. There's no such thing as a bad registry if it includes items you really want and need. And it makes it easy for guests to shop.
